REGULATIONS (Private Male/Female Candidates)

1. A regular certificate of C.T (General) or its equivalent examination (only for male candidates).
2. A degree of B.A / B.Sc from a recognized University with not less than 2nd division or In case of 3rd division at Bachelor level with M.A / M.Sc in 2nd division will also be eligible.
3. Two years continuous teaching service in a Govt. / Private recognized school after successfully qualifying the C.T (General) course. The period of eligibility of the candidates appointed in a Govt. / recognized school and appearing privately, shall be counted from the date of declaration of C.T (General) course result up to the last date (without late fee) of the submission of form for B.Ed. Examination.
4. At the time of submission of examination form to the University, the candidate must be in service within the jurisdiction of the University of Swat.
5. Non teaching personnel are not eligible to appear as private candidate in B.Ed. Examination.

General Rules and Regulation For Private Male and Female Candidates Serving in Private Recognized Schools.

1. The candidates from private recognized schools seeking permission to the B. Ed examination in private capacity should produce the service book with up-to-date entries which should be signed by the concerned school principal and duly countersigned by the EDO Education (Schools) male and female respectively.
2. Candidates referred to above can avail a maximum of four consecutive chances including the initial one, to clear all the papers, failing this would require fresh appearance in B.Ed. examination in all papers.
3. Private candidates (other than late college students/regular) are to get their forms, service record and photographs attested by the principal of the concerned school, to be countersigned by the E.D.O (male/female).
4. All private candidates working in private recognized schools should produce current two years recognition letter, issued by the competent authorities, non-production of which will render the candidates ineligible.
