2. Regular/late college students should submit their examination admission forms duly attested by the concerned

Principal of the college/Institute.

Examination fees should be deposited in the National Bank of Pakistan branches (University of Swat
Collection Account No. 3244316617) and Bank Al-Habib (University of Swat online collection Account
No.0080-901059-01). Fees remitted through money order/cross cheque or less than the prescribed amount
will not be accepted.

4. Last date means the last date on which the forms, complete in all respects accompanied by the relevant

documents and fee receipt/bank draft, should reach the office of the undersigned.

After the expiry of the last date for submission of forms with a triple fee, forms will be accepted till 15 days before the commencement of the examination with double of the triple fee.

6. Fees once deposited shall neither be refundable nor adjustable if the candidate is otherwise eligible.

7. It must be noted that the examination centre is allotted on the basis of a permanent address as mentioned in the examination admission form. However, the University reserves the right to allot the examination center anywhere based on the number of candidates in the area. Those who would like to be examined in a place other than their permanent address should send their own/parent's service/residence certificate with the form.

8. Forms submitted/received after the prescribed period shall in no case be given any consideration.
